#### SCHOOLPOOL TERMS OF USE

SchoolPool Inc. ("SchoolPool) provides an online service known as Revelus (the "Service") that provides users with the ability to manage an executive search process in an online environment. # 4. Additional Terms Applicable to Applicants.
